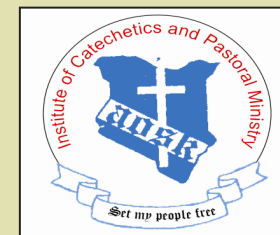
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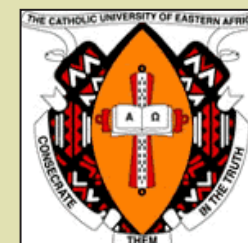

VISION

MISSION

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTE OF CATECHETICS AND PASTORAL MINISTRY ARE TO:

- Form pastoral agents who will handle catechesis at various levels.
- To prepare catechists as agents of evangelization who will be deeply embedded in the Christian faith.
- Offer opportunity for reflection and practice in the liturgical aspects of the life of the Church.
- Promote Inculturation according to the teaching of the Catholic Church.
- Offer opportunity for graduates or trained Catechists to advance their catechetical knowledge.
- To provide on-going formation for Spiritual Renewal.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

a) *Academic Qualification Requirements*

1. An applicant must satisfy any of the following minimum requirements for admission to a bachelors program.
 2. Be a holder of the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent with a minimum aggregate of C+. Or
 3. Be a holder of a Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education (or equivalent examination) with a minimum of two principal passes and one subsidiary pass;
Or
 4. Be a holder of a diploma or professional certificate in a relevant discipline from a institution recognized by the university senate:
Or
 5. Be a holder of any other qualification accepted by the university senate as equivalent to any of the above.

Applicants who hold either of the qualifications (iii) or (iv) above may, at the discretion of the senate, be exempted from some courses.

b) *Other Admission Requirements*

1. An application for admission shall be accompanied by a letter of recommendation and financial assurance from the applicant's superior, employer or sponsor
2. Applicants from non-English speaking countries must present evidence of proficiency in written and spoken English

COURSE DURATION

The duration of study for Bachelor's program is:

Either

1. Three and a half academic years or seven semesters for holders of the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent with a minimum aggregate of C+ or its equivalent. Those with philosophical background will take three years or six semesters.
2. Three and a half academic years for Holders of Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education (or equivalent examination) with a minimum of two principal passes and one subsidiary pass.
3. Two academic years for holders of relevant diploma certificates in theology, or Catechetics with a minimum secondary education aggregate of C+ or its equivalent .
4. Three academic years for holders of relevant Diploma certificates in Theology, or Catechetics, with a minimum secondary education Aggregate of C- or its equivalent with first class honours.
